Thursday, July 16th, 2009

Our 2nd annual Autocross will be held at the Evergreen State Fairgrounds in Monroe, Washington. Autocrossing is a motorsports event in which a course is laid out using traffic pylons as gates on a large, paved area, which is generally free from obstructions. Competitors are given the opportunity to walk through the course to familiarize themselves with the pattern and devise a driving strategy. Cars are then allowed onto the course one at a time, and the driver must navigate the course as quickly as possible, passing through each gate in the appropriate order. Typically each driver is allowed at least three attempts, or runs, with the fastest time recorded as their competition time.

Tech starts at 7:00am.

Space is limited to 80 vehicles
(Ford powered only)

All vehicles must pass a technical inspection.

Saturday, July 18th, 2009

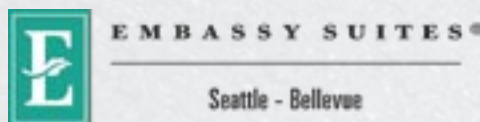

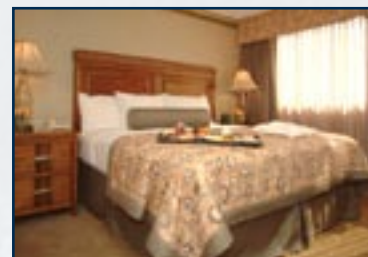

Take Exit 11A and follow the signs to 156th Ave. SE. The ramp will merge you onto So. 150th heading north. Proceed to the second stoplight (SE 28th St), and turn left into BCC's main entrance and follow signs to the show.

From Westbound I-90:

Take the 156th Ave SE exit and stay in the left hand lane. Turn left on SE Eastgate Way and get into the right lane. Turn right on 150th Ave SE (this becomes 148th SE). Turn left on Landerholm Circle SE and follow signs to the show.
